<p>Further Provisions on the Employer’s Obligations as a Personal Data Controller</p> <p>Following the enactment of the Personal Data Protection Law in 2022, in late August 2023, the Minister of Communication and Informatics (“MOCI”) published the draft Government Implementing Regulation of Law No. 27 of 2022 on Personal Data Protection (“Draft GR”).</p> <p>The Draft GR will include a more specific and in-depth article on the personal data protection provided for under the PDP Law as its implementing regulation. The GR will cover the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the determination of specific personal data; • claims and requests for compensation from personal data owners from personal data controllers for errors or negligence in the processing of their personal data; • the supervision of personal data controllers of personal data processing by third parties; • mergers, separations, acquisitions and consolidations of personal data controllers; • the authorities of the PDP Agency; • cross-border data transfer requirements; and • alternative dispute settlement. 	<p>The MOCI has issued a statement to the effect that the GR will not be issued until the end of 2023 at the earliest.</p>	<p>Employers should watch the development of the Draft GR and review their internal policies on processing personal data, to make sure they comply with the prevailing laws.</p>
